HB 711 – HB 711 Open Enrollment will likely be taken up in the Senate Education Committee sometime next week. New talking points will be emailed out to MARE member schools on Monday. Please reach out to your senators now and ask them to vote “No” on this legislation. 249 school districts, representing 438,572 student lives have passed resolutions in opposition to Open Enrollment. Working together, we can defeat this legislation again!

MARE Scholarship Information – MARE will award a total of 65 (up from 61 last year) scholarships this year including 22 - \$1,000.00 scholarships to college juniors/seniors & 43 - \$750.00 scholarships to graduating seniors from MARE member school districts = **Total of \$54,250.00 (up from \$51,500 last year)**. Since 2017, MARE has awarded \$316,250.00 in scholarships to students interested in becoming teachers! **(Articles on website soon!)**


