Missouri Arts Council Professional Development

As the arts education program specialist for Missouri Arts Council [MAC], I have been developing a new program of arts-centered schools called A+ Schools Missouri—it's part of a national consortium called A+ Schools Network. This model is focused on whole-school arts integration and transformation. MAC will provide the funding and personnel to train Missouri schools that meet the requirements through an application process.

Briefly, this is ongoing and intense professional development that builds competencies in 8 areas (the A+ Essentials): arts, infrastructure, curriculum, climate, collaboration, multiple learning pathways, experiential learning, and enriched assessment. The result [over 30 years in established network states] is higher levels of engagement, achievement, and overall satisfaction of both learners and teachers.
